The Mathematics department has a new Honours Math program for our secondary 2 students that will be continuing as of September 2019. Students wishing to pursue this program must obtain an overall average of 90% or greater (final course grade) and receive a recommendation from their current secondary one math teacher.

The program will be intense and students should be self-motivated and ready to undertake this challenge. The program is intended for students who are strong academically, self-motivated, capable of using their mathematical knowledge and intuition to solve challenging problems, have a passion and enthusiasm for Mathematics. Students will be permitted to remain in the program and continue into NS 4 and/or NS 5 Honours Math in subsequent years if they maintain their grades in the course.

This information will also be presented to students at the options assembly in the month of April.
